A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AT-WILL EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, City and Chip Rerig executed an Agreement effective February 2, 2016 to provide City Administrator services to the City;

WHEREAS, on the basis of the annual performance evaluation, the City Council desires to amend the employment agreement to increase the City Administrator's deferred compensation "Age 50" Catch-Up to the maximum annual contribution (\$6,000).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA DOES HEREBY:

Authorize an amendment to Section 8 (Benefits) of the Employment Agreement to read as follows:

A. Deferred Compensation. City agrees to provide a Section 457 deferred compensation program which will be administered by CalPERS or Nationwide (whichever Administrator chooses), and to pay into such program for Administrator's benefit, in January of each year, \$1,500 per month, or \$18,000 annually. In addition, the City deserves and hereby agrees to contribute the "Age 50" Catch-Up to the maximum annual contribution (\$6,000). The parties acknowledge that Administrator's previous employer, the City of Monterey, offered a pension plan with a 2.7% at 55 formula, while the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea offers a pension plan with 2.0% at 55 formula.

The City's contributions to the Section 457 plan addressed in this Amendment is for the express purpose of addressing the differential as set out above.
