

CARMEL PREPARES

Before a disaster happens take these steps to prepare:

- Sign up for alerts (Monterey County, PG&E, Nixle, City of Carmel)
- Know your evacuation routes
- Make a Family Plan - where to meet if separated, phone numbers, pet plan, and prepare a "Go-Bag"

Disaster Preparedness Resources

Basic Disaster Supplies Kit:

- Water (one gallon per person)
- Food (non-perishable), pet food
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio
- Flashlight
- First aid kit
- Extra batteries
- Whistle (to signal for help)
- Dust mask
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags
- Manual can opener
- Wrench or pliers (to turn off utilities)
- Local maps
- Cell phone with charger
- Medications, pet medications
- Extra glasses

- Water
- Medicine
- First Aid Kit
- Collar and Leash
- Traveling Bag
- Sanitation Needs
- Veterinary Records
- Photo of You and Your Pet
- Pet Toys
